We hope that April showers bring May flowers, and that the rain stays away on April 8 so that we can all (safely!) view the near-total **SOLAR ECLIPSE** right here in South Charleston. We have several eclipse-themed programs planned. At each of these events, participants will receive a pair of safe eclipse viewing glasses to take home with them (one per household).

First up, we'll have a **Learn About Solar Eclipses** program from 6-7pm on Tuesday, April 2. Alternatively, pop into Auditorium A after school on Friday, April 5 (anytime between 3pm and 4:30pm) to make & decorate your own **Pinhole Projector** to use during the eclipse. Finally, join our **Eclipse Watch Party** on Monday, April 8, starting at 2pm. Maximum visibility (92.6% coverage!) will occur at 3:13pm. In the event of inclement weather, we will live-stream the eclipse inside.

We also have LOTS of storytimes planned, and hope you'll join us for **Spanish Storytime** (Tuesdays at 10:30am), **Words & Wiggles** (Thursdays at 10:30am), and/or **Saturday Storytime** (offered this month on April 20 at 10:30am).
